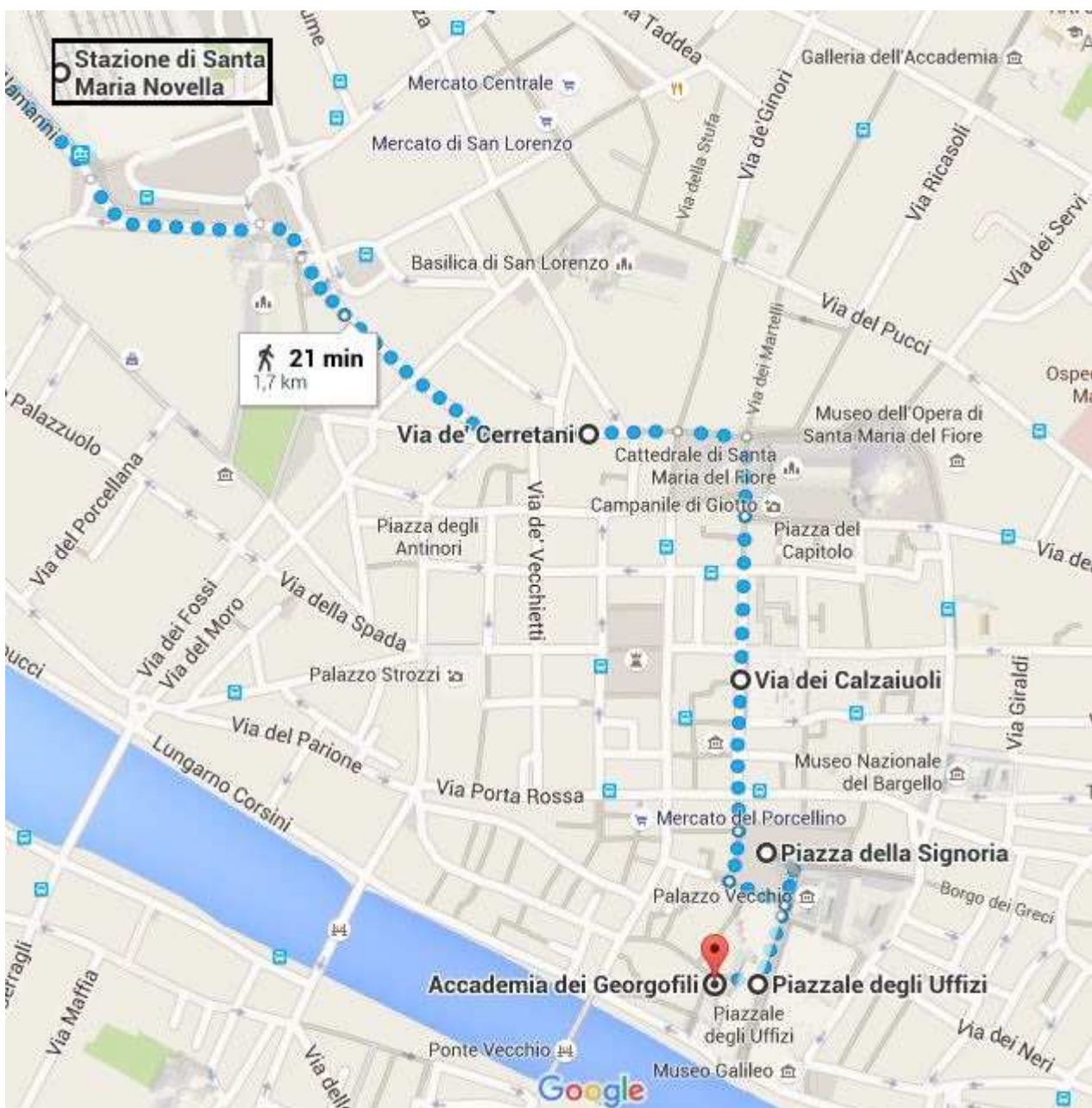

HOW TO GET TO

By airplane: If you arrive at Florence's Amerigo Vespucci airport, you can take the shuttle bus "VOLA IN BUS" to the train station of Santa Maria Novella or taxi.

By train: Fast trains (AV) connects Rome and Milan to Firenze in approximately 1h:40mins and are very frequent during daytime. From the Firenze main station Santa Maria Novella you can easily reach the Accademia dei Georgofili on foot in about 20 minutes. From the SMN train station, head down Via Cerretani to reach Piazza del Duomo, take Via Calzaiuoli to the right toward Piazza della Signoria. Once you face Palazzo Vecchio, head to its right side and at this corner between Palazzo Vecchio and the Loggia dei Lanzi, to the main entrance of the Uffizi Gallery. Then take Via Lambertesca, you'll have arrived.



HOTELS

There are many hotels & B&B in the vicinity of the venue (pedestrian area) and the participants can choose one at their preference using one of the many booking facilities currently available on the Internet.

April is a busy touristic period, but the offer of accommodations is very large.
